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




## The craftsmen's alley, or a brief history of the Schipfe

On the left bank of the Limmat, directly below the Lindenhof, only a few steps away from the great hustle and bustle of the opposite side of the river, crafts and small trades have been at the centre for centuries.

Since the early Middle Ages, this section of the riverbank has served as a landing place for river barges transporting goods and people. From the 16th century onwards, a flourishing textile industry turned this guarter into a mile, where silk, floret silk, wool and flax were processed into fine fabrics that were famous as far away as New York. Newcomers included engravers, shipbuilders, printers, tailors, window makers and envelope makers. Many traces of this history can still be found on the Schipfe today. Not only in the architecture of the buildings, but also in the trades that are still practised here: tailoring and goldsmithing are represented on the Schipfe. An upholstery studio, a leather bag maker, bookbinders as well as hairdressers and florists line up here. Two social projects complement the location with gastronomy and the sale of Swiss design products. Boats also continue to leave from here: the so-called Waidlinge of the Limmat Club glide elegantly along the banks of the Limmat, reminiscent of earlier times and Venetian gondolas...
